




## 1. Breathe – You Still Have Time

Not uncommon for schools to sign in March and April and start implementation in the summer

You're probably further along then you realize



# 2. Confirm Your Budget

- Don't let budget drive the process, but it is a factor
- 2 How much are you currently spending?
- Give a range to school leadership; you don't want any surprises
- Addition by subtraction if the SIS is robust enough, you might be able to cancel other applications



# 3. Define Responsibilities

(1) Create a decision-making process

- 2 We recommend a RACI (or DACI)
  Model
- Make the process inclusive, but clearly define roles



# DACI Roles

**Driver** - Responsible individual in charge of making sure a decision is made.

Approver - People who make the final decision.

**Contributer -** Experts that driver asks for help + perspectives

Informed - People informed of the final decision.

# 4. Confirm Major Requirements

(1) Identify (and document) "The Why"

2 Identify key departments, but prioritize your parents and students



- (3) Keep it to "Must Have's"
- Skip the RFP, but use your requirements doc send these requirements to potential vendors *early*

## 5. Determine Your Timeline

Prioritize parents, students and faculty

- Determine which departments are essential, and when they need to move phase your implementation
- Communicate this timeline to all potential vendors they should be able to provide you sample timelines



## 6. Use Your Network

- Ask peer and aspirational schools what they are using (simple survey makes it easier for respondents)
- (2) Regional and national associations



3 ATLIS = good resource for technology department

### 7. Contact Vendors

- (1) Limit to 3-5 finalists
- Limit your staff that is a part of initial demos (use the RACI!) be mindful of people's time plus trying to schedule across divisions will slow down process



- (3) Be clear on timeline, but be flexible
- Prioritize demos of key departments you can add other areas of the system later

# 8. Survey Key Constituents

- 1) Use a survey tool more efficient and easier to analyze
- Stay away from technical questions
   the survey is about a "gut" feel;
   every system will work differently




## 9. Get Final Demos

- (1) Lingering questions? Focus on the "Must Haves"
- (2) Key departments that haven't seen the system yet?
- This shouldn't be more than 2-3 vendors



## 10. Selection & Communication

- Choose a system with your school's future in mind
- Development a communication plan but not much work is needed until later
- Remind people of "The Why" in every communication



Present to parent association and major constituents during the summer - make it about why the new SIS matters to them
